When a child is born to an unmarried mother, the mother is automatically granted sole custodianship. The father has no legal right to see their child without a court order. Legally, there is no presumption of paternity; this means that unwed fathers are not, by default, assumed to be biologically related to their children.

Some states consider an unmarried mother to have full, sole custody of a child, while other states consider two unmarried parents to have joint custody of a child. If the mother lives in a state that recognizes a joint custody arrangement , then the child's father automatically has visitation rights if the child's mother does not specifically file for sole custody.

When a married, opposite-sex couple has a child, the mother's spouse is presumed to be the father. In Michigan, this principle is extended to married same-sex couples as well under the state's Equitable Parent Doctrine (see Paternity Suit FAQs for a general explanation). But when parents are unmarried, establishing child custody/visitation and determining parental rights can get complicated, especially when there are disagreements over parentage.

If the parents were never married, the mother has sole legal and physical custody until a court order says differently. An unmarried father has no legal rights to custody or visitation of the child. Only a legal parent can ask the court for custody or visitation. A legal parent is also responsible for supporting a child.
